Technical questions

How do I get my free ebook?

Type your download code into the password box on the page. Voila! You should be able to download your ebook in EPUB or MOBI formats.

EPUB or MOBI?

EPUB and MOBI are two common ebook formats that are supported by most devices. If you have a NOOK, a Sony Reader or Kobo Reader, you want to download the EPUB file. If you read on a Kindle device, you want to download the MOBI file. If you have a tablet or smartphone (iPad, iPhone, Samsung Galaxy, Nexus devices), you can download either the EPUB or the MOBI file and read them in your app of choice.

How do I add my free ebook to my device?

There are so many different digital reading devices! Below find instructions for opening and adding your free ebook to your device of choice:

Reading on your computer

You can read either EPUB or MOBI files on your computer – you'll need to make sure you have an ereading software installed on your computer first, though.

For EPUBs, we recommend downloading Adobe Digital Editions. ADE is a free software which you can download here; make sure to set up your free Adobe ID.

For MOBI files, you probably want to use Kindle for Mac, Kindle for PC, or Kindle Cloud Reader (all are free). Download Kindle apps here; make sure to set up your free Kindle account.

Once you have your ereading software of choice installed, download the EPUB or MOBI and unzip the file. It should contain an EPUB or MOBI file named with the ebook title. Double click to open the file.

Adding your ebook to Kindle Devices

- 1. Download the MOBI file to your computer.
- 2. Unzip the file. It should contain a MOBI file named with the ebook title.
- 3. Connect your kindle device to your computer by USB cord. Copy or drag the MOBI file onto your Kindle, into your "Documents" folder.

Adding your ebook to NOOK Devices

- 1. Download the EPUB file to your computer.
- 2. Unzip the file. It should contain an EPUB file named with the ebook title.

3. Connect your NOOK device to your computer by USB cord. Copy or drag the EPUB file onto your NOOK, into the "My Documents" folder.

Adding your ebook to iBooks on iPad, iPhone, or iPod Touch

- 1. Download the EPUB to your computer.
- 2. Unzip the file. It should contain an EPUB file named with the ebook title.
- 3. Open iTunes. Drag the EPUB file onto the iPhone or iPad's icon in iTunes. This will copy the ebook to your iBooks library automatically.
- 4. You can also email the EPUB to your email address associated with your device (or add it to a folder on Google Drive or Dropbox). Navigate to the EPUB file on your iPad, iPhone or iPod Touch and it will open in iBooks.

If you prefer to read through the Kindle App on your iPad or iPhone

- 1. Download the MOBI to your computer.
- 2. Unzip the file. It should contain a MOBI file named with the ebook title.
- 3. Email the unzipped MOBI file to your email address associated with your iPad or iPhone (or add it to a folder on Google Drive or Dropbox).
- 4. On your iPad or iPhone, open the attachment in your email. Tap the "Open in Kindle" dialog menu that appears.

Adding ebooks to your Droid Phone or Tablet via Google Play

- 1. Download the EPUB to your computer.
- 2. Unzip the file. It should contain an EPUB file named with the ebook title.
- 3. Visit https://play.google.com/books/uploads. There are two ways to upload a book: from your computer or via Google Drive (free online file storage service from Google).
- 4. Choose the method you prefer (direct upload from computer or via Google Drive), find the EPUB file and click "upload." Your ebook will be displayed in your Google Play library across all of your devices that use Google Play.
